



Additional Information and Resources in Sacramento County

The list of used oil recycling centers on the last page of the student lesson book includes locations throughout Sacramento County. Most accept filters as well as used motor oil.

Curbside collection service for used oil and filters is available to customers who have individual trash service in most parts of the County. (Note that this is not available to residents of multifamily housing with dumpster service.) The container should be set next to (not in) the recycling carts on the regular service day. An empty container will be left by the hauler when the full one is picked up.

Most areas of the County have similar services, though it varies with different garbage service providers: some provide containers for oil and zip-lock bags for oil filters. Some require a phone call to schedule, while others only require set-out on your regular recycling day. Check the websites or phone numbers below for details. There is also other recycling information at the local websites.

The Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Area is located at the North Area Recovery Station, 4450 Roseville Road in North Highlands, and is open Monday-Friday from 6:30 am – 6:00 pm and Saturday-Sunday from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. Used oil and filters as well as other toxic materials are accepted from residents. There is no charge.
