



## Additional Information and Resources in Yuba-Sutter Counties

There is no curbside oil recycling in either of these two counties, but there are about 12 oil recycling centers where you can take your used motor oil. Two of these sites will take used oil filters as well; the Yuba-Sutter Household Hazardous Waste Facility and the Marysville Transfer Station.

The Yuba-Sutter Household Hazardous Waste Facility is located at 134 Burns Drive in Yuba City and is open to residents on Saturdays **ONLY** from 8am- 4pm.
